I am proud to share Ulman Foundation has officially launched the **Beyond Cancer Campaign**—our boldest philanthropic effort to date. With a goal of \$10 million, this campaign will transform the way we care for adolescents and young adults facing cancer by addressing **every patient, every journey, every step**.

Cancer doesn't only affect the body. It disrupts every part of life. That's why this campaign is about more than treatment—it's about reimagining care so that young adults have access to the emotional, nutritional, logistical, and social support they need to move through cancer and beyond it.

Since quietly launching earlier this year, we've already raised more than **\$4.4 million** in early commitments.
